


Volunteer Ministries







VOLUNTEERING AT YOUR CHURCH CREATES A LEVEL OF DEPTH AND FELLOWSHIP BEYOND JUST ATTENDING SERVICES.

Church volunteer opportunities are ways to get plugged into the church, serve Jesus, and use your God-given skills and gifts. Some examples of church volunteer opportunities are secretarial duties, folding bulletins, mentoring others, helping with holidays or special events, and providing support or instruction to people in need. Volunteering can also have a spiritual benefit and make you want to dive deeper into the life of the church.



Are you musically inclined - join the worship team or assist with special music.

Do you have artistic skills? -the lobby or hallways of your church are a great place for painters, photographers, sculptors, and other visual artists in your congregation to display their work. Photographers and videographers can always be used to capture important moments like baptisms, church events, etc. Talk to your Pastor about using your artistic skills to beautify your church or bulletin boards.

Do you have technical skills? You could assist in the sound booth with Audio/Visual, or webpage design and maintenance, or social media presence.

Do you like to be physically active? You could volunteer to organize or lead a group to promote healthy lifestyles through walking, running or cycling.

Do you have a vehicle? - There may be individuals in your church who do not have a vehicle or are not physically able to drive themselves to church. You could volunteer to pick people up and bring them to church and get them home afterwards.

Do you like to visit with people? Speak to you pastoral care team to see if there is an opportunity for you to help out with mentoring, home visits, nursing home visits, or phone calls to shut-ins or to follow up with new attendees.

Your church has a variety of volunteer opportunities waiting to be filled: Sunday School Teacher, Bible Study leaders, cleaners, snow removal, grass cutting, general maintenance, counters, and more.

Tim and Michelle Eby have served as commissioned missionaries with the Church of the Nazarene for 22 years in Africa. Tim grew up on the mission field in Papua New Guinea with his parents Lee and Carol Ann Eby. Michelle is also a missionary kid from Beirut, Lebanon where her parents Larry and Sharon Buess served with the church of the Nazarene. Tim has a B.S. in Aviation Technology, his commercial pilot licenses, and began his career as a commercial pilot in Atlanta, Georgia.

In August of 1997, they were assigned as Nazarene missionaries to the Africa East Field to open the work for Nazarene Mission Aviation as a missionary pilot.

The Ebys returned to the USA in 2003, where Tim completed his course of study, received a Master's in Christian Education, and was ordained as a minister in April of 2006. They returned to Africa in November 2006. Tim worked in leadership development and church planting in the country of Senegal and across the Africa West Field for the next 11 years, and Michelle served as the field treasurer. They moved to Johannesburg, South Africa in January 2018 where Tim is now serving as the Africa Regional Jesus Film and Evangelism Coordinator. Michelle is serving on the finance team for the Africa Region.

They have 4 children, 4 grandchildren, and call Nashville, TN their home. God continues to work through the ministry of Tim and Michelle as they serve Him on the mission field. Their passion is to see the development of national leaders who will lead the church in Africa to maturity and significance. Their positions require much travel and great wisdom as they develop tools of evangelism and discipleship that are effective for the African context. Please pray that God will give them strength, wisdom, and safety as they teach and preach the Good News of Christ in every corner of Africa.

Your church will be contacted by someone on the deputation team in order to firm up these host dates.






